Principles

Learning matter is maximum but learning time is minimum, therefore effective learnings depend :

1. Understanding the background and objective.
2. Timely participation.
3. Actively participation.
4. Group work for better understanding.
5. Regular review of the different sessions.
6. Regular reporting for documentation.

Group Work

It is necessary to understand and exploration of a learning theme through organizing a group work which includes:

1. Form a group with similar type of persons / partners.
2. Explore the idea or theme to the group member.
3. Collect and record the findings from the group member.
4. Present findings.
5. Collect recommendations from the whole group.
6. Finalize the findings as report.

Individual Activity (Daily Review)
