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Description:

The course is designed to enable students to think anthropologically on language including key analytical concepts in linguistics, socio-linguistics, and other traditions of linguistic study. It also explores the complex relationships among language, culture and communication and offers precise knowledge on linguistic diversity of the world and languages spoken in Bangladesh. The course also offers theoretical and methodological insights from the rich tradition of anthropological study language along with in-depth understanding of the linguistic tools and methods used in ethnographic research.

Objectives:

- 1) Understanding of the premises in linguistic studies.
- 2) Understanding anthropological tradition and approaches to the study of language.
- 3) Clear understanding of linguistic diversity and practices and the complex ways they determine socio-cultural formation of a society.
- 4) Introducing students to the history, ideas and issues in linguistic anthropology.
- 5) Orienting students to theory and methods in structural linguistics
- 6) Enabling student to apply linguistic methods and theories in their further studies.

- 2) Ability of the students to explore and explain critical junctures among language, culture and communication and how they shape our socio-cultural life-worlds.
